E-cigarettes were once advertised as a healthier choice than regular cigarettes. Their sweet flavors and cool designs have made the public believe they are harmless. __36__, the truth is e-cigarettes contain nicotine (尼古丁), which can lead to addiction and lung damage. Kimchi is a traditional Korean pickled (醃漬的) dish. It's mainly made with napa cabbage, and lots of seasonings (調味料), such as pepper and salt. In old times, Korean people put pickled kimchi into large pots, and buried them in the ground. The aim was to stop the kimchi freezing during the winter months. In the summer this method also kept the kimchi cool enough to slow down the fermentation process(發酵過程). Nowadays, people store kimchi in refrigerators. The first kimchi was recorded in the early period of the Three Kingdoms (37 BC - 7 AD). Korean people at that time were skilled in making fermented foods and drinks such as wine. Without refrigerators, the pickling of vegetables was a good way to keep foods. In the beginning, kimchi wasn't made hot. The use of hot peppers in kimchi became more common in the 19th century.
